## AFTERCARE ADVICE

Congratulations on your new tattoo! Taking proper care of your tattoo during the healing process is essential to ensuring that your tattoo looks its best for years to come. Please follow these instructions carefully:

### Tegaderm Bandage Aftercare:

These products have been put to the test by artists throughout our industry and proven to work best in healing. Tegaderm comes in many brands such as Saniderm, Recovery, Second Skin, etc. Each brand has slight variances in their adhesive formula.

Artist will put on a bandage when finished with the tattoo. The bandage stays on for up to 5 days. During this time, your tattoo will weep fluids of plasma, blood, and residual ink. This is completely normal. As long as that fluid is not leaking out of the bandage, leave it alone. If fluid is leaking out, then bacteria can leak in, and we recommend changing it. Though rare, if you have an allergies to bandage adhesive, please let your artist know as we will recommend traditional aftercare methods.

### traditional aftercare:

#### Day 1-2:

1. Leave your bandage on for 1-2 hours.
2. Gently remove the bandage and wash your tattoo with warm water and mild, fragrance-free soap.
3. Pat your tattoo dry with a clean, dry towel or paper towel.
4. Apply a thin layer of aquaphor to your tattoo to keep any seepage from drying out..

#### Days 3-14:

1. Wash your tattoo 2-3 times a day with warm water and mild, fragrance-free soap.
2. Pat your tattoo dry with a clean, dry towel or paper towel.
3. Apply a thin layer of fragrance-free, unscented lotion or coconut oil to your tattoo to keep it moisturized.
4. Dont touch with dirty hands and avoid picking or scratching your tattoo, as this can cause scarring or infection.
5. Avoid direct sunlight and tanning beds, as these can fade your tattoo and increase the risk of reactions
6. Avoid soaking your tattoo in water (baths, hot tubs, swimming pools) for at least 2 weeks.
7. Avoid wearing tight clothing or anything that rubs against your tattoo.

#### General tips:

- \*Always wash your hands before touching your tattoo.
- \*Avoid using anything abrasive (scrubs, loofahs, etc.) on your tattoo during the healing process
- \*Refrain from mixing aftercare products and regiments and only follow instructions given to you

Remember, the healing process can take several weeks, and everyone's body heals differently. If you have any questions or concerns, please don't hesitate to contact me.
